















PREPARING FOR YOUR PET'S WELLNESS SERVICE APPOINTMENT

Pets age more quickly than we do, and they are masters at hiding what's going on inside (a survival skill needed in nature, but that can cause issues now that they are domesticated). A healthy adult pet should receive Wellness Services with their veterinarian once a year.






Your pet's exam will consist of:

-  Nose-to-tail comprehensive exam
-  Discussion about pet's diet, preventative medicine regime and exercise routine
-  Monitoring of your pet's vitals including weight
-  Assessment of your pet's dental health
-  Yearly fecal testing to screen for parasites like giardia, roundworm, hookworm and whipworms all of which can be transmitted to humans
-  Yearly Blood Work to check on functions of the internal organs, blood cell count, blood chemistry, metabolic functions as well as other functions of the body. Having a baseline is the gold standard of care for all pets no matter what age. Lab work is less expensive and the least invasive way to get a look at what's going on inside your pet
-  Thyroid Testing to check the function of the thyroid
-  Urinalysis and Collection to screen for inflammation, infection, and disease
-  Screening for Heartworm and Tick borne diseases
-  Parasite prevention assessment
-  Discussion around behavioral changes
-  Core vaccinations and a custom plan for other vaccinations that may benefit your pet due to their lifestyle
