



PREPARING FOR YOUR DOG'S WELLNESS CARE APPOINTMENT

Pets age faster than we do, and are masters at hiding signs of illness or injury. While this is an essential survival skill for wild animals, it causes issues for domesticated pets. A healthy adult pet should see the veterinarian once a year for routine wellness and preventative care. Annual baseline blood work is the gold standard of care for pets of any age, and lab work is a less expensive and less invasive way to evaluate the internal health of your pet.

Your dog's exam will consist of:

- Comprehensive nose-to-tail exam
- Monitoring of weight and vital signs
- Discussion about diet, exercise, and preventative medications
- Dental health assessment
- Parasite prevention assessment
- Discussion around any behavioral changes
- Blood work to evaluate internal organ function, thyroid function, blood cell count, blood chemistry, metabolic function, and more
- Screening for heartworm and tick-borne disease
- Urinalysis to screen for infection, inflammation, and disease (sample collection included)
- Fecal screening for parasites like Giardia, roundworm, hookworm, and whipworm - all of which are transmissible to humans
- Core vaccinations and a custom plan for any needed lifestyle vaccinations
